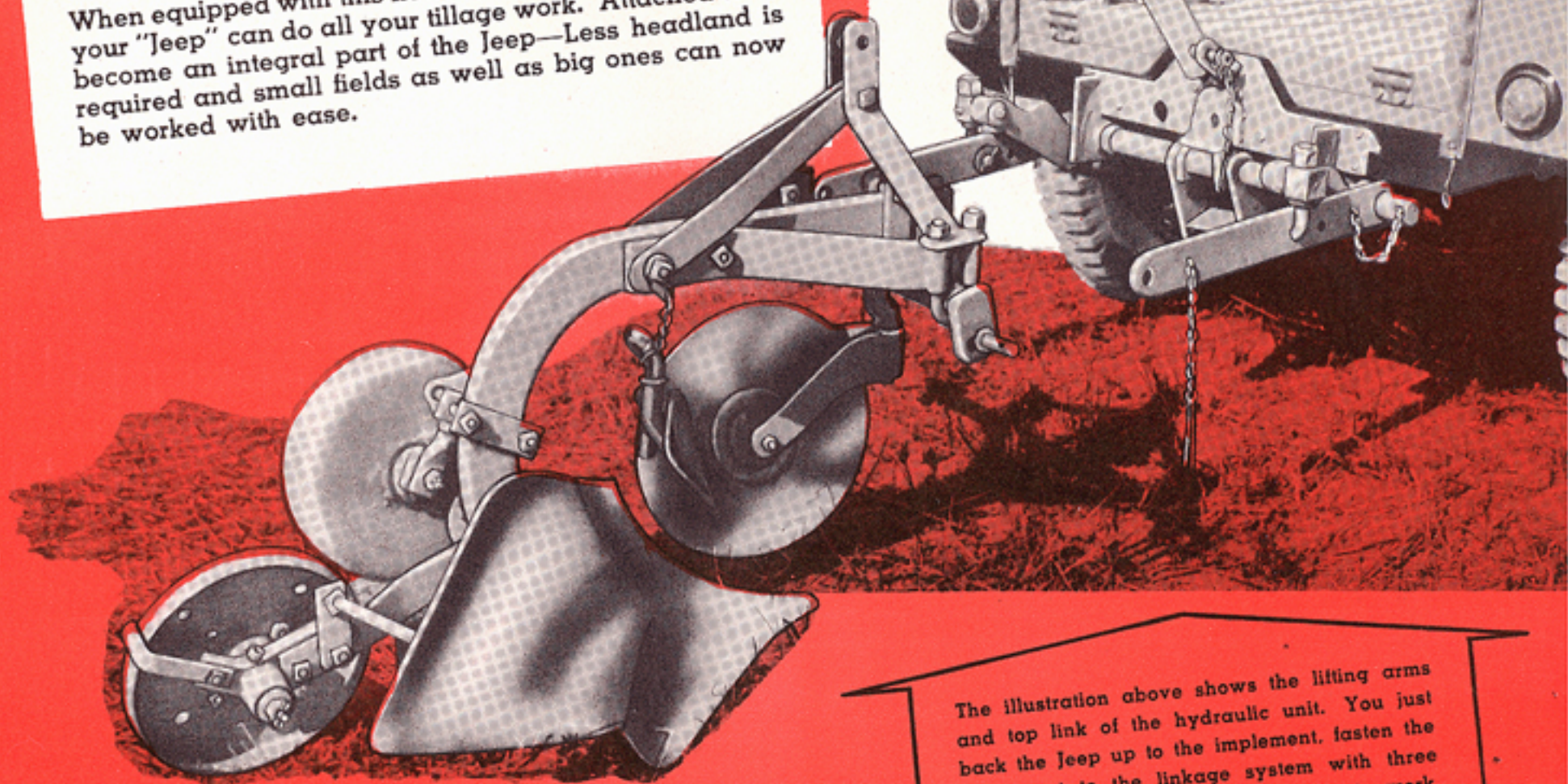


FOR JEEP OWNERS

When equipped with this new hydraulic linkage system, your "Jeep" can do all your tillage work. Attached tools become an integral part of the Jeep—Less headland is required and small fields as well as big ones can now be worked with ease.



The illustration above shows the lifting arms and top link of the hydraulic unit. You just back the Jeep up to the implement, fasten the implement to the linkage system with three simple pins and you're ready to go to work.

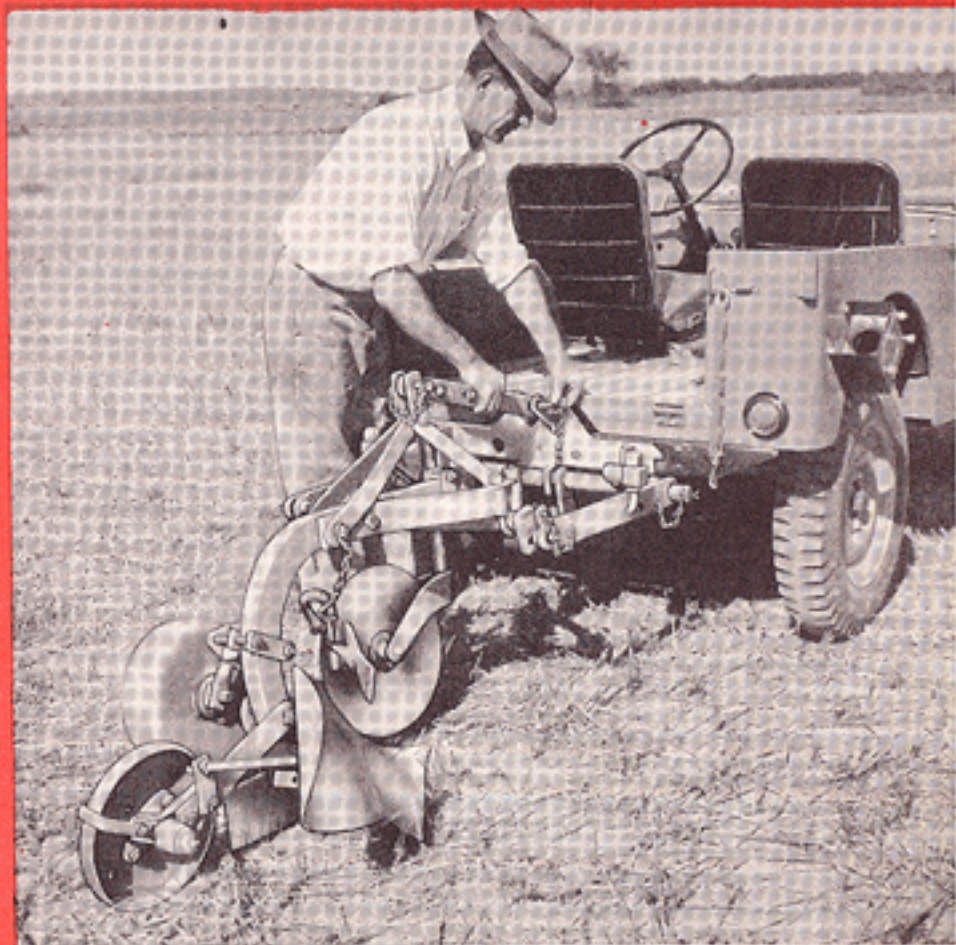


FINGER-TIP OPERATION

Just a touch of the control located between front seats and hydraulic muscles go to work for you.

THREE POINT HITCH — Quick on, Quick off.

It's only a matter of minutes to attach or detach a tool. Lifting arms can be raised or lowered from rear of Jeep as well as from the driver's seat. You can back your Jeep into a corner of the shed and drop the implement in its proper place, all in a matter of minutes. It's just as easy and quick to back up to the implement, attach it with three simple pins and head for the field.

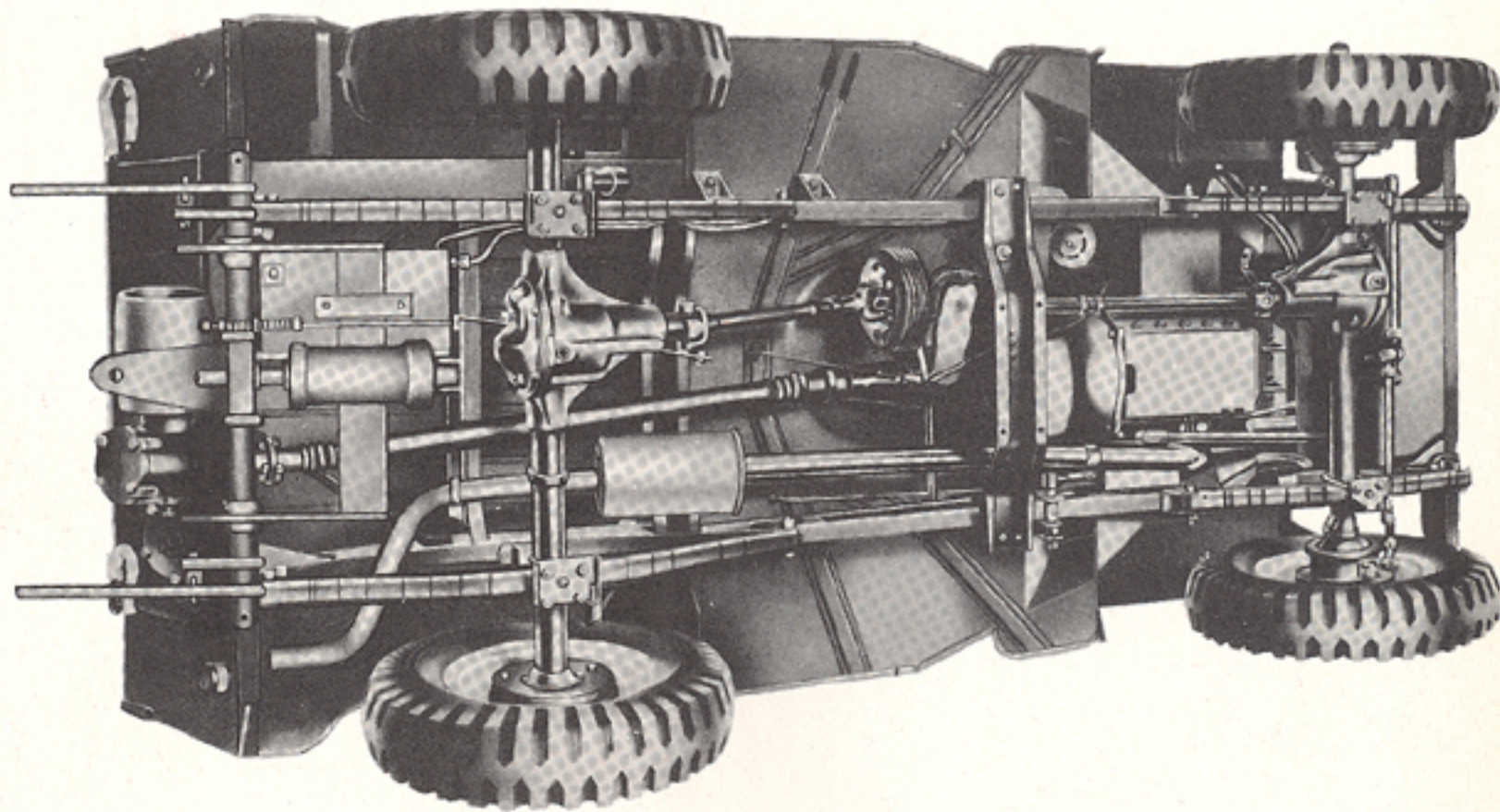

Shown above is the bottom view of the Jeep equipped with the hydraulic linkage system.

The control, located between the front seats (and also at the rear of Jeep) operates the valve, which directs hydraulic pressure to the cylinder. The operation of the cylinder raises the lifting arms and the attached implement.

Shown at the lower right are just a few of the many Newgren farm tools that are available for use with the "Jeep", equipped with the hydraulic linkage system. The linkage system does not interfere with belt pulley or power take-off operations. When your field work is completed, the lifting arms can be readily removed and your Jeep can be used for any other purpose.
